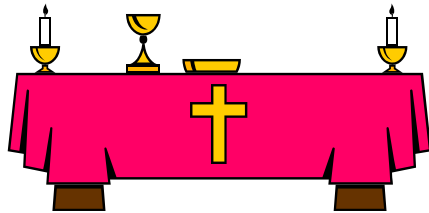

## What is an Adult Server?

An Adult Server is anyone who is 18 years or older and desires to serve this parish faith community in their acts of service during the Celebration of the Eucharist.

## Who can serve in the Adult Server ministry?

The Adult Server ministry is open to anyone over the age of 18 years and is a practicing member of our Catholic faith community.

## When will I serve?

In general, Adult Servers assist in the Celebration of the Eucharist on Saturday and Sunday masses and at other special liturgical celebrations held during the Liturgical Year.

## What is involved in serving in this ministry?

The main function of serving in this ministry is to assist the Celebrant in the Celebration of the Eucharist and understanding the liturgy.

Adult Servers serve in the following ways prior to the start of the Celebration of the Eucharist:

- Prepare the sacred vessels to be used during the Celebration of the Eucharist.
- Ensure enough members of each liturgical ministry are present to ensure the adequate involvement of each liturgical ministry in the Celebration of the Eucharist.

During the Celebration of the Eucharist Adult Servers assist the Celebrant by:

- Holding the Sacramentary and other books as required during the celebration.
- Prepare the altar for the consecration of the Eucharist.
- Assist in the distribution of the Eucharist.
- Clean up the altar after the distribution of the Eucharist
- Use of incense, as required, during the Celebration of the Eucharist.

After the Celebration of the Eucharist Adult Servers are required to:

- Clean and setup the sacred vessels to be used during the next Celebration of the Eucharist.

Adult Servers are also asked to assist at the Celebration of the Eucharist held during a Funeral Service.

## How will I be trained?

Workshops and training sessions are scheduled during the year, as required, to training individuals who have expressed an interest in serving in this ministry.

Occasionally refresher sessions are held for all Adult Servers to discuss current procedures and concerns expressed by Adult Servers. Training sessions are also held to discuss and train for any new procedures that are to be initiated in the Celebration of the Eucharist that involve the Adult Servers.
