INTRODUCTION:

Good liturgy requires good music and this can be expressed in many different ways in liturgy.

Parishioners with all types and all levels of musical skills and abilities are needed to participate in Music Ministry for regular Sunday masses and celebrations such as Baptisms, Confirmations, funerals and marriages.

All types of instrumentalists, vocalists and leaders of song are required to provide good liturgy at the various celebrations held at St. Theresa's and Corpus Christi parishes..

THE NEED:

Every weekend at St. Theresa's and Corpus Christi parishes there are 8 masses that need the involvement of member of the Music Ministry to enhance the Celebration of the Mass. That is a total of 416 masses per year. This does not include other celebrations that would be enhanced through the participation of people involved in the Music Ministry.

At the moment there is an urgent need for individuals with all types of musical and instrumental skills to participate in St. Theresa's Parish Music Ministry.

Training will be provided for those who would like to be a part of this ministry but have concerns about their music abilities and skills.

Plans are also in the works to form a Men's Choir at St. Theresa's Church. All men with instrumental talents and a voice are invited to join this new group.
